Form I-290B must be revised to allow the agency to identify the beneficiary of the filing or receipt number of the matter from which the appeal or motion is being taken. Currently Agency receipt notices do not identify the beneficiary of the underlying matter, nor specify the underlying matter by reference. In circumstances where a petitioner may file multiple appeals or motions to contest more than one adverse decision, there is no clarity as to which matter has been receipted under which motion.
