The enrollment forms for Head Start are very redundant based on the HHS mandated collection of paperwork the Head Start agencies must collect before the child can enter the HS program.

If there were one piece of paper to let go of it would be the enrollment form. Most Head Starts that I used to audit and the one I work for now have an electronic system in place that show all the child's information (above and beyond the normal child care setting) and then shows where the child is located and the program he/she is in; HS, EHS, etc.
