- 1. Never leave a child unattended in or near water.**
- 2. Teach children how to swim.**
- 3. Install proper barriers, covers and alarms on and around your pool and spa.**
- 4. Ensure all pools and spas – both in your backyard and any public pool you may visit – have compliant drain covers.**
- 5. Teach children to stay away from drains.**
- 6. Know how to perform CPR on children and adults.**


