It is also a felony for any person to sell or otherwise dispose of a firearm to any person so convicted. (4) the convicted offender was represented by counsel, or knowingly and intelligently waived the right to counsel; (5) if entitled to have the case tried by jury, the case was actually tried by jury or the person knowingly and intelligently waived the right to have the case tried by jury;							
 The Department of Defense has, by policy, expanded the prohibitions contained in Title 18 Section 922(g)(9) to those military or civilian personnel who have felony convictions for crimes of domestic violence. Convictions of crimes of domestic violence do not include summary court-martial convictions, the imposition of nonjudicial punishment (Article 15, UCMJ), or deferred prosecutions (or similar alternative dispositions) in civilian courts. Furthermore, a person shall not be considered as having committed a "crime of domestic violence" for purposes of the firearms restriction of the Gun Control Act unless all of the following elements are present: (6) the conviction has not been expunged or set aside, or the convicted offender has not been pardoned for the offense or had civil rights restored, unless the pardon, expungement, or restoration of civil rights provides that the person may not ship, transport, possess or receive firearms. (7) For the case of a sole conviction of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence against an individual in a dating relationship, five years has not elapsed from the later of the judgment of convicted offender and the custodial or supervisory sentence, if any, or the convicted offender
