The Application for Certificate of Citizenship (N-600) is used to obtain a Certificate of Citizenship which serves as evidence of your or your child's U.S. citizenship. You may file this application if you were born abroad and are claiming U.S. citizenship at birth through your parents. You may also file this application to obtain evidence of citizenship if you automatically became a U.S. citizen by operation of law after your birth but before you turned 18 years of age.
