Hope all is well. In reviewing the FR notice for comments ([Federal Register :: Agency Information Collection Activities; Submission to the Office of Management and Budget \(OMB\) for Review and Approval; Comment Request; Survey of Income and Program Participation \(SIPP\)](#)), I was wondering if there is information on the web (or in other public documents) on the current SIPP sample sizes (by year and wave) and target (eligible) samples, mainly to determine the impact of the statement, "35,000 housing units minus the total of *eligible housing units from earlier panels*." I am also wondering if the average case-level collection costs are available, or the estimated cost savings of reducing the eligible sample from 53,000 to 35,000.
