

The National Science Foundation (NSF) Graduate Teaching Fellows in K-12 Education (GK-12 program) is a crosscutting education initiative managed by the Division of Graduate Education in the Directorate for Education and Human Resources. The program supports fellowships and associated training that will enable graduate students and advanced undergraduates in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics discipines to serve as resources in K-12 schools.





Survey Privacy

The Federal Government has a continuing commitment to monitor its awards to identify and address any inequities based on gender, race, ethnicity, or disability of the Principal Investigators, Co-Principal investigators, Fellows, or other participants.

These are confidential files accessible only to appropriate NSF officials, their staffs, and their contractors responsible for monitoring, assessing, and evaluating NSF programs. Only data in highly aggregated form, or data explicitly requested "for general use," will be made available to anyone outside of the NSF for research purposes. Data submitted will be used in accordance with criteria established by NSF for monitoring research and education grant and in response to Public Law 99-383 and 42 USC 1885c. The Social Security number (SSN) will be maintained in accordance with the requirements of the Privacy Act of 1974. Submission of the SSN is voluntary. It is used for survey quality control, program evaluation, and matching with other data sets maintained in the Education and Training System of Records 63 Fed. Reg. 264, 272 (January 5, 1998).

Public Burden

Submission of the requested information is voluntary. Failure to provide full and complete information, however, may reduce the possibility for continuing support through the award/project subject to this survey. Each Principal Investigators' average reporting burden is 20 hours, each Fellow's average reporting burden is 2 hours, and each Cooperating Teacher's average reporting burden is 2 hours. 




