The forms divide the cattle groups differently than we do on the farm so we have to make fictitious cattle groups then you wonder why the numbers don't always total the same. If you would let us do the math as it is on the paddocks we are using all would be less stressful. We end up calling our certifier at least three times each year to clarify what we have to do to make it make sense to you. Another redundant form is input log and ingredient logs saying nearly the same thing. As far as pasture requirements go why not forget leaving farmers use other feed during pasture season?
