The Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) strongly supports the continued collection of data by the Census Bureau on the Information and Communication Technology Survey (ICTS). The data collected on the ICT-1 forms are critical to key components of BEA's economic statistics.

BEA uses data from ICT-1 to prepare the benchmark and annual input-output (I-O) accounts, the capital flow tables (CFT), and to validate critical estimates of communication technology in the national income and product accounts (NIPA) and the capital stock estimates. The collection of expensed ICT alongside capitalized ICT, both of which are considered investment in the NIPA, is especially useful to BEA since comprehensive information of this type is not collected anywhere else. The table below summarizes BEA's use of ICT-1 data in the national accounts.

Please keep BEA informed concerning any modifications to this form. We are particularly interested in any modifications proposed during the forms approval process that would substantially affect our use of these data.
