I-526 petition form should have a section where the investor/petitioner could list the members of his/her family who are derivatives.

Because there is no family information that could be inputted on the petition form, NVC could only issue the Visa Fee bill for the investor alone having the petitioner to request that the fee bills be revised to add his/her family.

This is an unnecessary additional step that could be avoided if the Form I-526 has a section on Family derivatives like in I-140 form.
