When a ship is in fresh water of unit density the appropriate load line may be submerged by the amount of the fresh water 2. allowance. Where the density is other than unity, an allowance shall be made proportional to the difference between 1.025 and the actual density. It is the owner's responsibility to furnish the master with approved information and instructions for loading and ballasting this vessel 3. to provide guidance as to stability of the vessel under varying conditions of service and to avoid unacceptable stresses in the vessel's structure, as defined in 46 CFR 42.09-1. 4. The periods and areas during which the seasonal load lines apply are as stated in the Load Line Regulations of 46 CFR 42.30, as appropriate. This Load Line Certificate will be canceled by the Commandant, U.S. Coast Guard, if --5. The annual surveys have not been carried out within three months either way of each anniversary date of the certificate. The certificate is not endorsed to show that the ship has been surveyed as indicated in (a). (b) Material alterations have been made to the hull or superstructures such as would necessitate the assignment of an (c) increased freeboard. The fittings and appliances for the protection of the openings, guardrails, freeing ports, or the means of access to the crew's (d) quarters have not been in as effective a condition as they were when the Certificate was issued. The structural strength of the ship is lowered to such an extent that the ship is unsafe. (e)

In accordance with the Load Line Regulations the ring and lines must be permanently marked by center punch marks or cutting.

When the Certificate has expired or been canceled, it must be delivered to the Assigning Authority.

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
