The WIA has also established a concern regarding some SCSEP programs need to be reevaluated because it was making it difficult to set employment expectations for the older workers in collaboration with WIA programs. For an elderly person with an extremely limited to non employment history will obviously have more than one barrier to

employment; which may include the following aspects such as lacking basic computer skills, English language proficiency, not having a high school diploma, or having a physical or developmental disability; being homeless; or living in a rural area where employment opportunities are limited. We need consider the SCSEP and WIA rulemaking as vital tools for advocating for equality for our elder population. *\square

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
