

## Caution: DRAFT—NOT FOR FILING

This is an early release draft of the 2018 IRS Form 1040, U.S. Individual Income Tax Return, which the IRS is providing for your information, review, and comment. **Do not file draft forms.** Also, do **not** rely on draft forms, instructions, and publications for filing. We generally do not release drafts of forms until we believe we have incorporated all changes, and we do not expect this draft to change significantly before being published as final. Forms generally are subject to OMB approval before they can be officially released. Early release drafts are at <a href="IRS.gov/DraftForms">IRS.gov/DraftForms</a>, and may remain there even after the final release is posted at <a href="IRS.gov/LatestForms">IRS.gov/LatestForms</a>. All information about forms, instructions, and publications is at <a href="IRS.gov/Forms">IRS.gov/Forms</a>.

Note that these are friendly shortcut links that will automatically redirect to the actual link for the page.
