Step 1:

Representative fills out the electronic G-28 and shares it with the client for their review.

The Notice of Entry of Appearance as Attorney or Accredited Representative is for attorneys and accredited representatives to provide information to establish their eligibility to appear for and act on behalf of an applicant, petitioner, requester, beneficiary or derivative, or respondent in immigration matters.

An attorney or accredited representative must complete and submit a new G-28 form for each client case. The G-28 can be started along with a client's new case or it can be added to a client's already-submitted case. USCIS will only recognize a completed G-28 once the client has reviewed and signed the form.

After you provide your representative information and signature, we will give you a one-time access code to give to your client. Your client will need to sign in to his or her USCIS account (or create a new one) and enter this code to officially link to your G-28. Your client will also need to review the information you provided in the G-28 and provide his or signature before you can continue with filling out an online form for him or her.

Once your client links to and signs your G-28, a link will appear on your account homepage that takes you to the online form you want to complete on behalf of your client.

Your client reviews and signs

After you are finished filling out your client's online form, he or she will need to sign in to his or her account to review the information you provided in the online form and then provide his or her signature.

You submit and pay

Once your client reviews and signs the online form, a link will appear on your account homepage that takes you to a page to submit the G-28 along with your client's online form, and pay the fee for your client's form (if there is one).






