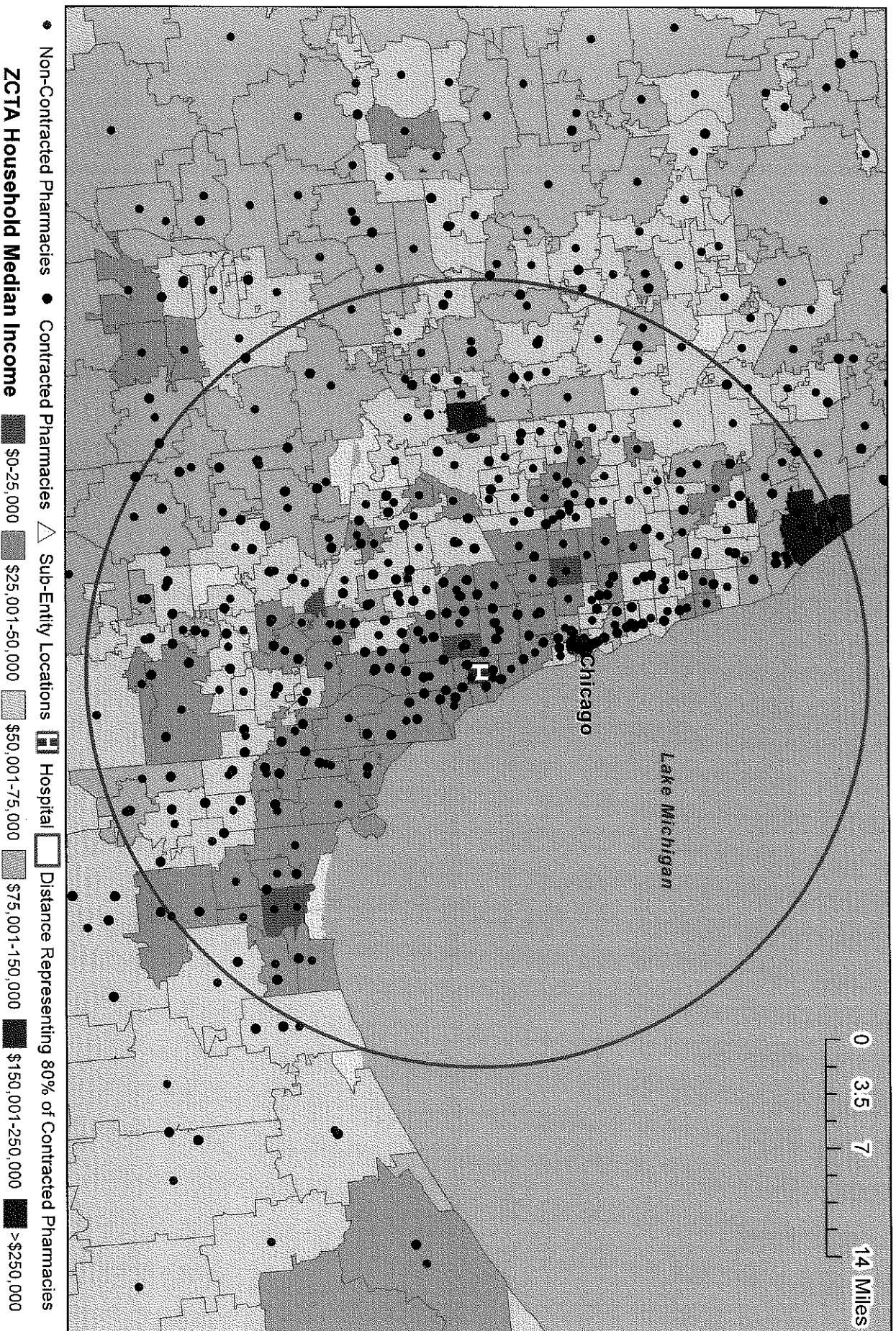
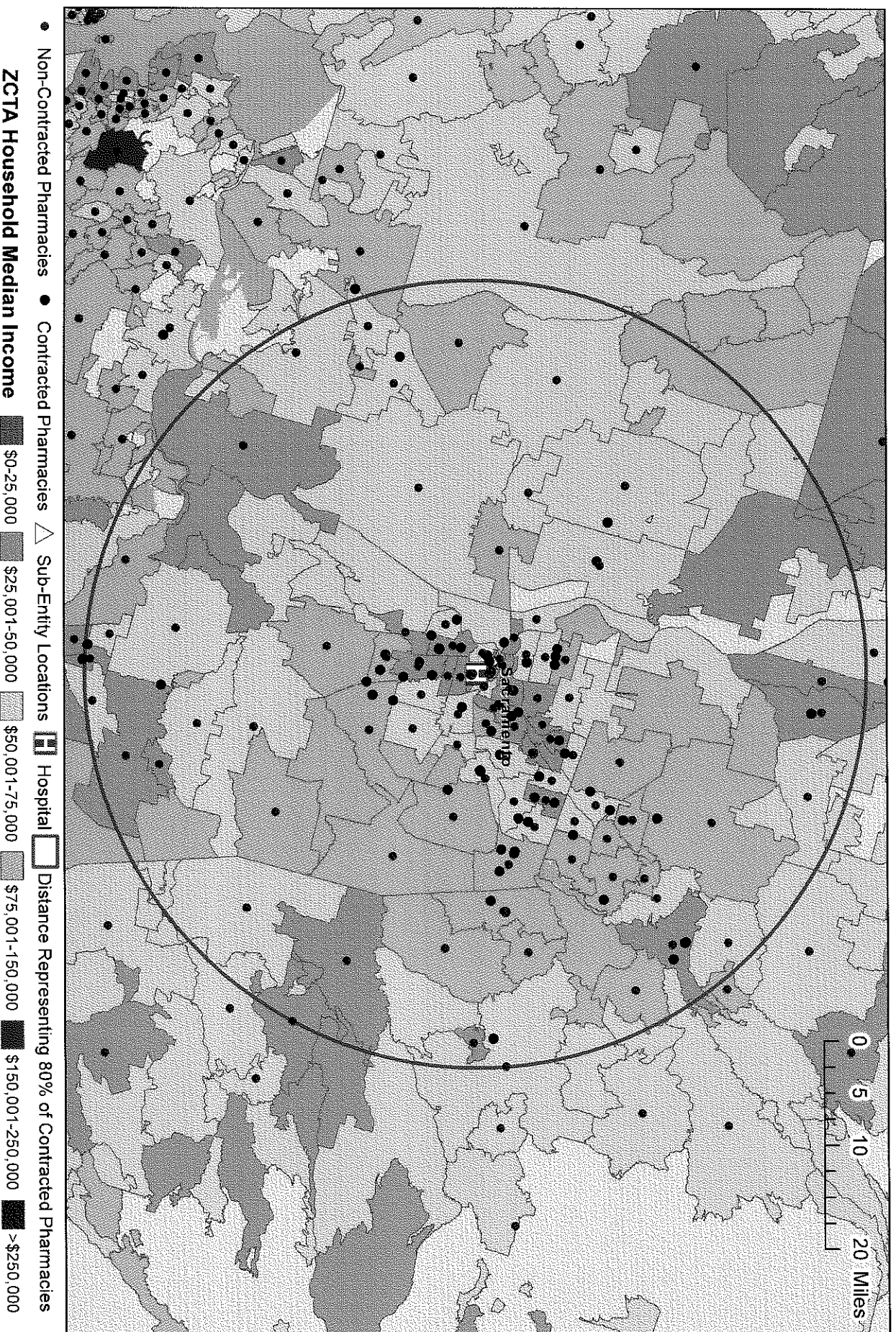

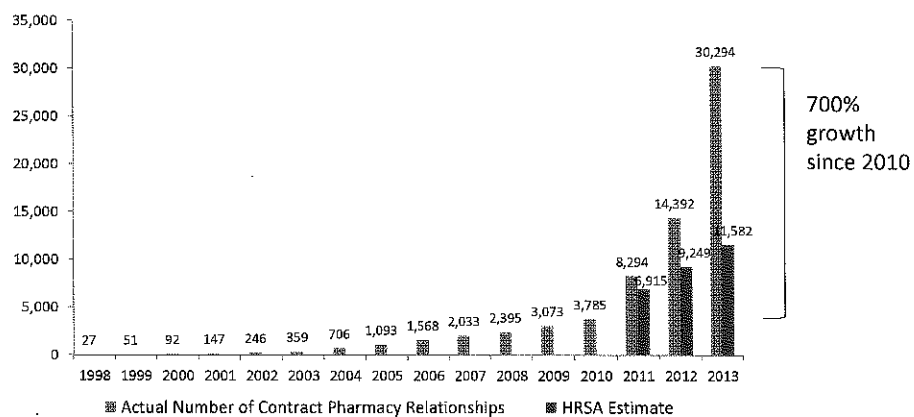

## Contract Pharmacy Growth Accelerating Rapidly

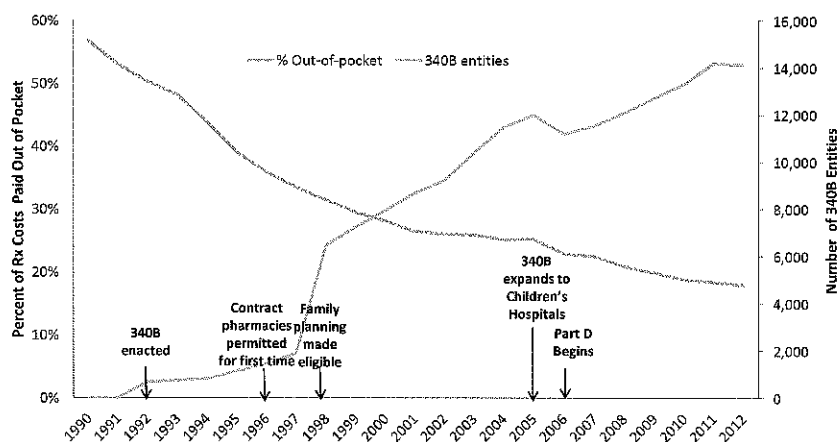
**39% of contract pharmacy relationships are with a consolidated health center and 44% are with a DSH hospital.**
