Postdoc pay increased from 1997 to 2013, with largest year-to-year increases in 1999, 2002, and 2003. Postdoc pay and population show a positive correlation (Pearson's R=0.88). These data suggest that universities and principal investigators (PIs, supervisors) were able to accommodate consistently increasing postdoc salaries as well as hiring more postdocs at these higher rates.


