SUMMARY: The National Indian Gaming Commission (NIGC or Commission) is publishing an agenda

of its open and anticipated rulemaking actions. In accordance with Executive Order 12866, "Regulatory

Planning and Review," and the Regulatory Flexibility Act (5 U.S.C. 605), executive agencies publish

semiannual regulatory agendas in the Federal Register each year. The agenda is a general

announcement to the public intended to provide notice of rulemaking actions in which the public may

wish to participate. It appears in both the online Unified Agenda, www.reginfo.gov, and in part II of the

Federal Register that includes the Unified Agenda. The NIGC invites questions and public comment

on individual agenda items.
