The Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) strongly supports the continued collection of data by the Energy Information Administration (EIA) on the Residential Energy Consumption Survey (RECS), Forms EIA-457 A-G. This important survey is our only data source for several key components of BEA's economic statistics.

Information from forms EIA-457 A-G is critical in preparing the benchmark and annual estimates of personal consumption expenditures for tenant-occupied nonfarm permanent-site housing in the national income and product accounts and the input-output accounts. RECS data are used to estimate, and remove from reported contract rents, the utilities billed with rents. A list of items used by BEA is provided in the attachment below.
