I am writing in opposition to the proposed changes to the USTR Large Civil Aircraft portal.

The tariffs at issue are in response to Large Civil Aircraft and Digital Service Tax disputes, and have nothing to do with the wine or hospitality industries. If they remain in effect, increase, or expand, the supply chain will continue to lose jobs. Its not just sales reps and somm jobs were fighting for: warehousing jobs. Trucking jobs. Administrative, logistics, and marketing jobs. American jobs. The American three-tier system is built nearly entirely of small- to medium-sized businesses. US wholesalers- these same small- and medium-sized businesses- represent an overwhelming majority of not just irreplaceable in the market EU goods, but also the most lauded grower-produced domestic wines distributed nationally.

These tariffs are at odds with the health of America's wine and hospitality industries which employ millions of people. These industries cannot sustain any more setbacks after this already difficult year. Please reconsider the proposed changes to the USTR Large Civil Aircraft portal.
