I identified two items that need to be corrected in the Enrollment and Disenrollment section of the proposed Medicare Part C Reporting Requirements data for the 2021 collection period. It was correct when we last reviewed the document (see attached) but it appears to have been changed at a later point.

Data Element "F" in subsection #2 (Disenrollment) is missing the word "determinations." It should read as follows:

Of the total reported in E, the number of favorable Good Cause determinations.

Data Element "G" in subsection #2 (Disenrollment) refers to Element G instead of Element F. It should read as follows:

Of the total reported in **F**, the number of individuals reinstated.
