Associate Administrator Srinivasan:

General Motors, LLC (GM) is responding to the Notice. The Notice was published on July 14, 2020 and is seeking comment on issues related to a proposed collection of information per procedures established under the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 that require the Agency to request public comment prior to seeking approval for the collection of information from the Office of Management and Budget.

GM is a strong advocate for public communication and education programs aimed at improving traffic safety and reducing injuries and deaths associated with motor vehicle usage. We recognize the potential hazards of drowsy driving and applaud the Agency's efforts to investigate and quantify attributes associated with this behavior. We look forward to reviewing the results of NHTSA's research on both a national level and for the four states that have drowsy driving laws or program activities.

GM is willing to review and/or provide input related to content of the survey prior to its distribution to the public. We are also willing to be contacted for further discussion of the results and subsequent development of countermeasures for future communication and outreach efforts.
