Re: Comments on DFC's Development Outcomes Survey (DFC-008)

Dear Ms. Reynolds,

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the United States International Development Finance Corporation's (DFC) Development Outcomes Survey (DFC-008). As civil society organizations and practitioners who advocate for accountability in development finance and support those who have been harmed by development projects, we have a deep interest in ensuring that DFC's projects adequately address risks to communities affected by these projects, which can undermine the sustainability of DFC's investments.

DFC-008 will be the principal document used by DFC to review and update a client's developmental impact profile and determine the project's compliance with DFC's policies. Several reports, including a recent report from the USAID Office of Inspector General (OIG), outlined shortcomings in OPIC's monitoring practices, including in the monitoring of development outcomes.¹ The reports in particular criticized OPIC's reliance on client-provided data for reporting on the performance of projects.²

Proper monitoring of projects is essential to ensure that DFC's investments are having their intended positive benefits and are properly avoiding, mitigating, and remedying any negative impacts to project-affected communities. This is particularly true for investments

in financial intermediaries, which can come with significant risks around clients' adherence to environmental and social safeguards and can also have less institutional oversight of subprojects.³ It is important to strengthen DFC-008 and DFC's assessment of the information in the form to facilitate DFC's proper monitoring of projects. Importantly, relying on clients to report back on projects is not enough for a comprehensive view of a project's performance or environmental and social impacts. DFC should accompany any changes to DFC-008 with an increased commitment and devotion of resources to project site visits and monitoring.⁴

DFC-008 replaces the former OPIC Self-Monitoring Questionnaire (OPIC-162). Several signatories to this letter submitted recommendations on OPIC-162 on June 14, 2018,⁵ and in its response, OPIC stated that our recommendations would be considered in a future revision.⁶ We direct DFC to address the comments and redline edits that we previously provided. Additionally, we have provided suggested edits in a redlined version of the form (attached). Our edits include recommendations on the following topics:

Environmental and Social Impacts

DFC-008 includes some questions on the environmental and social impacts of the project. However, some of these questions fail to require detailed information about the client's actions to address the identified negative impacts. Our suggested modifications (sections 2, 3, and 12) aim to ensure that DFC receives comprehensive information on the impacts of clients' projects (changes highlighted and in bold):

and ongoing complaints and whether the mechanism undergoes a regular third party audit to assess its effectiveness.

In Section 12, we commend the questions regarding displacement and resettlement. However, considering the impacts of involuntary resettlement, DFC should require more information on the resettlement action plan (changes highlighted and in bold):

Community Consultations

Projects that respect the rights of project-affected communities are only possible when communities are consulted early in the project development process and continuously throughout the project cycle. DFC must ensure that applicants have processes in place to ensure robust consultation and must acquire Free Prior and Informed Consent (FPIC) from affected communities. DFC-008 includes a question on community consultations and requires attaching documentation. To make this question more robust, the question should be revised in the following manner (highlighted in bold):

Q1201. Has the Project engaged with communities impacted by the project throughout every stage of project design and implementation (including disadvantaged and vulnerable groups)?

Additionally, the examples of disadvantaged and vulnerable groups included in the pop-up for this question and other questions in DFC-008 should be expanded to include populations that are marginalized because of social status, disability, sexual orientation or gender identity, age (including children), health status or political opinion, and those who have little flexibility to rebound when disruptions to their livelihoods occur due to their economic and social circumstances.

Prior and Ongoing Project Complaints

We appreciate the inclusion in DFC-008, per our previous recommendation on OPIC-162, of questions on past or ongoing community dispute or complaint resolution processes. While it is positive that these questions are included, they can be strengthened by additionally asking about Independent Accountability Mechanism (IAM) and Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) National Contact Point (NCP) complaints. Several international financial institutions (IFIs) have IAMs that receive complaints concerning IFI-financed activities and offer to convene the complainants (often members of project-affected communities), the IFI's client, and other relevant parties to resolve the conflict, conduct an investigation to determine if the IFI's environmental and social policies have been violated, or both.

Similarly, governments adhering to the OECD Declaration on International Investment and Multinational Enterprises, including the United States, are required to establish an NCP to receive complaints (known as "specific instances") against companies that are operating in or from their respective countries and that have allegedly violated the standards in the OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises. NCPs are able to offer "good offices," which can include conciliation or problem solving, to the complainants and the company to facilitate the resolution of the dispute.

To minimize risks to DFC and its investments, as well as affected communities, DFC should additionally require the applicant to disclose prior or current IAM or NCP complaints against the project, applicant, any related party or affiliate of the applicant, or any supplier to the project (changes highlighted and in bold):

Furthermore, these questions should also be included in the section for financial services clients and projects. Although investing in financial intermediaries (FIs) can help mobilize funds and attract private capital for economic development, this type of lending also comes with significant risks, particularly around clients' adherence to environmental and social safeguards. It is therefore crucial that DFC's FI clients have robust environmental and social practices, including human rights, environmental, and social due diligence and monitoring of sub-projects as well as accountability and access to remedy, including through DFC's IAM, for project-affected communities. DFC must properly monitor FI clients to ensure that they abide with these practices.

Protections Against Reprisals

Globally, individuals defending their human rights and the environment have increasingly faced intimidation, violence, and reprisals. DFC-008 should include a question on the applicant's protocol for preventing and addressing threats of and actual retaliation against complainants or those associated with project complaints or grievances. We recommend adding the following question in Section 12:

QXX Does the Project have a protocol to prevent and address threats of or actual retaliation against grievance mechanism complainants and those associated with Project complaints or concerns? Yes / No
