Are we agreeing to what is in the first paragraph where the Yes"/"No" boxes are, or to all of the information below that? Are we agreeing to surveys, or will we also be solicited for services we don't want?

I don't want my information shared with SBA because there are too many examples of government agencies failing to protect personal information. Also, this suggests more dissemination of personal information which will lead to less security. I find it quite disturbing that I must share my private information with an entity that I will not meet with or believe has my best interest for me.
