Mr. Riley:

In response to Federal Register publication 2021-08116, I submit comments concerning the information collection reporting system for Public Law 102-477 Indian Employment & Related Services Consolidation Act.

After review of the current reporting structure, the Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe recommends additional time to assess what other form changes may be necessary, given the recent inclusion of new Federal partners and the ongoing work to revise the interagency MOA. As the BIA is well aware, the Bureau, Tribes, and the other agencies participating in the 477 Program are currently undertaking an effort to update the P.L. 102-477 reporting form. Until that effort is complete, the current reporting form should be extended unchanged.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the development of these forms; this is vital to efficient operation of Tribal 477 programs.
