Dear Lauren,

I wish to add the following public comment to the 86 FR 16392 regarding the O*NET Data Collection Program.

Regarding *Work Activities*, it would be incredibly useful to have estimated time/effort allocations for the various work activities. Within the system of the national accounts, there are various assumptions regarding which occupations perform certain tasks and their overall contributions (e.g., software is developed by computer programmers using 50% of their time). Having better data regarding the share of jobs within an occupation that perform a task and the distribution of the time/effort allocations would help identify ways to improve those methods. These estimates are quite important for measuring intangibles such as investment in software and valuing data related activities.
