- Specific dates can be chosen collaboratively between the host institution and the summer fellow
- Program provides housing at each institution for 10 weeks
- Program provides a \$4,000.00 stipend to cover living expenses
- Open to rising junior and senior undergraduates
- Must be a US citizen or permanent resident
- Support for travel to and from research institution
- Two-day summer undergraduate research conference will be held at the NIH (date TBD)
