42 USC code (b)1 (b)6

Individuals who were deprived opportunity to collect damages after suffering a major planned activity must be granted relief.

Relief in the form of local housing or secretly using a third party is not legitimate.

The Higher Education act of 1965 and the Atomic Energy act of 1956 are acts of cruelty and abuse that created a life crisis and a situation of disaster that is yet to be resolved.

A Tort Claim for \$100 Million Dollars USC was ruled in favor of the victim of major crime. "Myself". Relief is yet to be received.

The theft of my private educational and business documents exercising the Patriots act and claiming to be a national security risk is subject to the Fifth Amendment and Compensation equal to the loss value is being

requested.

The documents are valued at \$80 million dollars USC

The documents were private property and proof of Business, Student, and entity status.

The losses of the settlement and losses of the documents are due to a specific National Disaster Announcement made in 2015.

Just compensation in the amount lost "deprived" is being requested by the individual who continues to suffer from the protected events, and the attacks that involved violations of bodily integrity and gross negligence domestic violence, document theft.
