On behalf of the 50,000 members of the School Nutrition Association (SNA), we appreciate this opportunity to comment on the Food and Nutrition Service's Agency Submission for OMB Review; Comment Request, USDA National Hunger Clearinghouse Database Form (FNS 543), OMB Control Number: 0584–0474, published in the *Federal Register* on February 22, 2022. This request is related to a collection to conduct data collection of food and nutrition non-profit organizations addressing hunger and nutrition.
