What?

We at ICF, a research and evaluation firm, are doing a project with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to learn more about your health teacher. What am I Being Asked to Do?

You will take a short, one-time survey asking questions about the teacher that delivered health education.

How long will it take?

The survey should take no longer than 20 minutes to complete.

No. All your survey answers will be kept private. We will not be collecting your name or any other information about you. No information will be shared with your classmates, parents, or teachers.

What are the Risks?

Taking part in the survey is not expected to cause you any harm.

What do I get?

To thank you for taking the survey, your class will receive a class-wide thank you gift valued at \$100. If you do not answer all the survey questions or decide to stop at any time, your class will still get the thank you gift.
