General Comment

In response to the NRC specific questions proposed:

- 1. The proposed collection of information is NOT necessary to be captured on a new form. It is previously captured in the counselor's report. The information may have practical utility based on information gathered to support a claim.
- 2. The estimated burden for information collection appears to be incorrect. Bullet 9 of the Background states, ". The estimated number of hours
- needed annually to comply with the information collection requirement or request: 30 hours." If the number of estimated responses is 30, often times one hour per response is insufficient. This creates an unusually burdensome requirement.
- 3. To make the information more efficient, consolidate the Counselor's Report and the proposed new form
- 4. Minimizing the burden may be accomplished via automated systems; however, various departments, commissions, bureaus, etc. have consistently shown they are inadequate to provide security to the personally identifiable information.
