Usually I set aside about 2 hours a day for 2 or 3 weeks to get them done, double that if I have to do any records requests. Before electronic health records were available they took me at least a month and they would take me longer if I didnt have access to a fax, printer, and laptop with internet. (Medical records are much harder to access on mobile). I also have to coordinate schedules with people to check my work before i submit.
