I'm representative payee for my disabled child. The many, many times I've been forced to fill out the Continuing Disability Review for someone who can never "recover" (because autism doesn't just go away) it has taken at least 3 to 4 hours to go through the 15 page form. It then requires even more time, another 3 to 4 hours, to verify all of the information entered on the form to ensure I'm not submitting false information inadvertently. It's easily been a 6 to 8 hour job, having to fill out CDR paperwork & gather all required information.

The SSA's "estimate" that one hour is all that's needed to complete a CDR packet is frankly laughable. CDRs are extremely burdensome & greatly time consuming, to a far greater degree than SSA has "estimated". One wonders where this "estimate" originated, as it's so far from accurate or anything even close to the actual time needed to complete CDR paperwork.
