We write in response to the Social Security Administration's (SSA's) burden estimate regarding the time it takes to complete Form SSA-454-BK or the Continuing Disability Review (CDR) form. These comments are submitted on behalf of UCP Seguin or Greater Chicago. Our organization serves people with disabilities and helps to complete this form, and we must disagree with SSA's estimate.

- The form can require hours of work from people with disabilities and their families, but the amount of time varies depending on conditions and resources. We can confidently say that 1 hour is a completely inaccurate estimate of the time burden of this form.

We hope SSA will revise their burden estimate and take steps to simplify this form and reduce the burden it places on people with disabilities and their family, friends, and service providers.
