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I feel the Civil Rights Data collection has become an enormous process for small rural schools with limited resources to hire departments that can generate this type of data on an annual basis. I know if says semi-annual, however we have been spending hours collecting data for the last year or so and it appears once again this year. Since smaller rural school districts do not change a great deal, in regards to demographics, perhaps schools in rural areas (population under 10,000) and/or school population less than 1500 students should be exempt from these reports (or) only report during the census years. The other options would be for OCR to compensate (at 100%) school district for time and effort over normal reporting.
