Comment

The proposed change in language is welcome and improves the contextualization of disaster events in current community conditions. Asking applicants to describe their plans for accessibility accelerates a provider's early thinking about how to align their CCP services with community functioning and what resources they need to do so. Considering these more tangible factors needed for accessibility will enhance a plan for intentional engagement of hard-to-reach community members, and may promote relationship building with community networks who meet these needs regularly. All of these factors support wider CCP programming and goals as well.
