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The issue I see with such a policy is individuals from less stable countries, or in areas where health services have questionable results (see blood transfusions, and doctors selling vaccines to black-market, and replacing it with who knows what in China).

If we want to require a vaccination prior to entry in the US why are we requesting it done under institutions we have zero no confidence in? Why not require the shot once in the US? Do it immediately upon entry, or just drop the requirement all together.

What is the practical difference if any, of an individual presenting a "record" you cannot verify, or getting a shot of sugar water thinking it was the vaccine, and an individual coming in with no "record" of ever have gotten the vaccine?
