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

Videos should run no longer than 30 seconds and be submitted in MP4 formats at less than 20 MB in size. Submission for video should also include a featured screenshot or still of your video with similar requirements for photo submission.

Along with your submission, please provide your name, institution, email address, a brief title (<50 characters), and a short caption (100-150 characters) for your entry. For the caption(s), please include information on the method used, fluorescence, stains, and/ or other relevant details. We encourage you to write for a lay audience.
