This is a mandatory collection and FNS uses the information collected to ensure integrity of SNAP-Ed funds, demonstrate program effectiveness, and track SNAP-Ed outcomes and impacts. This collection does not request any personally identifiable information under the Privacy Act of 1974. According to the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 (PRA), an agency may not conduct or sponsor, and a person is not required to respond to, a collection of information unless it displays a valid Office of Management and Budget (OMB) control number. The valid OMB control number for this information collection is 0584-0594. The time required to complete this information collection is estimated to average 53 hours per response. This burden consists of the time it takes the State SNAP-Ed agency to track and report their SNAP-Ed activities data and coordinate with implementing agencies (where relevant) to review and combine their information for the submission of a single statewide Annual Report.
