Why hasn't the USFWS imposed federal punishment on illegal Hondurans who kill and eat bald eagles in Nebraska?

When did the USFWS start issuing hunting permits for bald eagles? The ESA prohibits take of listed species unless a Federal permit is issued that authorizes such take. The ESA's definition of "take" includes hunting, shooting, harming, wounding, or killing, and also such activities as pursuing, harassing, trapping, capturing, or collecting.

A bald eagle was killed during nesting season in Stanton County Nebraska by two Honduran illegals in early March 2023. The illegals admitted they shot the bird and wanted to eat it. Photographs cannot be released due to gore. Why have charges not been brought?

Could you please send me the program through which Hondurans can kill endangered American species?

Can you please send me the announcement that the USFWS will no longer uphold the Endangered Species Act?
