We appreciate the opportunity to provide comments on the U.S. Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) second procedural notice regarding quantitative research on front of package (FOP) labeling on packaged foods. Our organizations have an abiding interest in any FOP nutrition labeling on packaged foods.

The undersigned organizations appreciate the additional information FDA shares in this second procedural notice, including the overall study design, mock product labels, planned FOP nutrition labeling schemes for testing, and results of the agency's review of the literature on the effectiveness of FOP schemes from other countries. However, given the complexity of the material and the consequential nature of the agency's work, we feel strongly that the 30-day timeline for comments is not sufficient. More time is needed by the food and beverage industry to fully understand the information and compile detailed feedback that will help the agency formulate a scheme to advance public health goals.
