The Registry holds all the derivative styled names and allows my adding other derivative names, e.g. SEAN S. HAGGERTY vs SEAN SCOTT HAGGERTY vs SEAN HAGGERTY along and other more mangled sytles of the name even my A.F. Oath of Office fictitious name SEAN S. HAGGERTY 2LT, USAFA on my OPM DOD DD214 records are all reported/linked to my BNC# of the National Creditor Registry;

Also, the National Creditor Registry also has email, mailing addresses

If only the U.S. Bankruptcy Court had additional fields, whether elective or mandatory, that would allow the added BOI elements, the existing BNC registration is to me a GREAT way to remove redundancies; Between usa.gov and V.A. and SAM.GOV, DUNS, ID.ME, IRS, SSA, FAA, FCC's FRN#, etc., there are so many places to keep up to date

We do not consider the middle name or suffix part of the legal name,

So the "First & Middle" name (if there is a middle name) goes in the First Name Field, just as the Surname suffix goes into the Last Name Field for SSA Purposes
