There is conflicting placement of a footnote between the Reporting Requirements and Technical Specifications for the Organization Determinations and Reconsiderations (ODR) report.

DETAILS:

2024 Reporting Requirements, Section II. Organization Determinations and Reconsiderations; pg. 9:

- Please confirm if footnote #2 under Subsection #5 Reopenings / Data Element N is placed correctly. "2 The date of disposition is the date the required written notice of a revised decision was sent per 405.982." 2024 Technical Specifications, Section II. Organization Determinations and Reconsiderations; pg. 14:
- Please confirm if footnote #1 currently under Subsection #2 Disposition should be moved to Subsection #5 Reopenings / Data Element N on pg. 15. "1 The date of disposition is the date the required written notice of a revised decision was sent per 405.982\*".

We feel footnote #2 placement in the Reporting Requirements is correct, however we feel the same footnote (#1) in the Technical Specifications is misplaced. Moving the footnote in the Technical Specifications to Subsection #5 - Reopenings will ensure the Reporting Requirements and Technical Specifications align and will eliminate confusion.

2024 Part C Reporting Requirements Draft, pg. 9: Section II. ODR; Subsection #5 RE-OPENINGS; Data Element N: the element Description states "Date of reopening disposition (revised decision)2 (footnote)";

Footnote 2 states: "The date of disposition is the date the required written notice of a revised decision was sent per 405.982."

2024 Part C Technical Specifications Draft; pg. 14: Section II. ODR; Subsection #2/"DISPOSITION1 – ALL ORGANIZATION DETERMINATIONS1 (footnote)";

Footnote 1 referenced states: "The date of disposition is the date the required written notice of a revised decision was sent per 405.982\*".
