I reviewed the "Secure Software Development Attestation Form" and have a few comments:

Some minimum requirements should include:

Version Control-this ensures that integration can be cleanly performed on projects with multiple engineers, and bugs can be tracked and software versions can be precisely identified. Additionally, if a codebase was compromised, version control would allow the owners to see changes.

Test Automation-this ensures that changes can be quickly validated in an automated manner and can help avoid vulnerabilities that are obvious (ie Memory corruption and crashes) when parts of the software are executed during testing. Of course this can not be exhaustive, but it will help catch the low hanging fruit.
