AUTHORITY:

The United States Secret Service (Secret Service) is authorized to collect the information requested on this form pursuant to 18 U.S. Code § 3056 - Powers, authorities, and duties of United States Secret Service.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this survey tool shall provide the Secret Service's National Threat Assessment Center (NTAC) with quantifiable data and validate the impact of outreach training efforts and is further used for the purpose to enhance training provided by NTAC based upon the survey data collected.

ROUTINE USES:

Information provided for this survey is used to evaluate and assess the effectiveness of NTAC's outreach training and to ascertain in whether to provide any follow-up training to its external partners.
