30-day Public Comments and Federal Responses

CDC received one public comment during the 30-day FRN period.

Comment 1. I believe the information collected in order to understand the relationship between HAB exposure and symptom-reporting is necessary and useful. The data collected attempts to analyze the different ways one could be exposed to HAB, including through respiration and consumption of aquatic species (whether these species were marine, or freshwater is something I am not sure about). This data is collected in a multitude of ways (air sampler, blood samples, etc.), which allows the data collected to be more accurate. I believe gathering information on which specific HABs cause the results seen in the information collected would be important knowledge that agencies could use to create needed regulations.
