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General Comment

The FBAR filing requirement places an undue burden on Americans who live abroad permanently. We are collateral damage in a system designed to find tax cheats. It is difficult and time-consuming to find the maximum amount of each account during a year, and the penalties for non-filing are overly harsh. Americans who live abroad permanently should be EXEMPTED from FBAR filing.
