Thank you, Jasmine. We will enter BEA's comments into the record.

In response to the suggestion about including adjustments on Form EIA-857, I'll share that we actually do collect and publish adjustments and revisions every month, just not as a standalone series. During the monthly data quality review process, we solicit explanations and/or revisions to submitted data. As revisions come in, we review and publish them with each *Natural Gas Monthly* publication. Revisions are denoted with the superscript R in the PDF publication. Take a look at Table 14, for example, and you'll see R's on the vast majority of values, due to benchmarking with our annual survey, Form EIA-176, which was released the end of September: <a href="https://www.eia.gov/naturalgas/monthly/pdf/table\_14.pdf">https://www.eia.gov/naturalgas/monthly/pdf/table\_14.pdf</a> If you were to just look at our data via the website Navigator, you would have no way of knowing when and if values are revised: <a href="https://www.eia.gov/dnav/ng/ng">https://www.eia.gov/dnav/ng/ng</a> cons sum dcu nus m.htm

Regarding comments on Form EIA-895, it sounds like you are aware of this, but that "form" is not part of this package. However, I will share your letter with them to let them know its importance to the BEA. I put the word "form" in quotes because it is not actually a survey form, but rather a family of data series that EIA employees scrape from state data agency websites.

Thank you for your comments and you are invited to comment again when the 30-Day FRN is released.

The Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) strongly supports the continued collection of data by the Energy Information Administration for the forms referenced in the Federal Register notice.

BEA uses the information collected on these forms to prepare the benchmark and annual input-output (I-O) accounts. The information from these forms also provides data for the estimates of gross domestic product (GDP), GDP by industry, GDP by state, and national personal income accounts. The accompanying table lists the items from the various surveys used by BEA.

The Federal Register notice (FRN) indicates the possibility of beginning to collect information on form EIA-857 that captures any adjustments to prior periods in the current monthly report. This information will be valuable in improving the accuracy of actual consumption for every period. BEA would use the added information from this survey to improve the process of calculating quarterly GDP by industry as well as benchmark and annual I-O.

In addition to the surveys mentioned in the FRN, BEA relies heavily on data once collected on form EIA-895, "Annual Quantity and Value of Natural Gas Production Report." BEA uses this information to prepare estimates of gross national output and product by state. Specifically, the data are used in the benchmark and annual I-O, as well as the GDP by state and GDP by industry.

Please keep BEA informed about any modifications to these forms. We are particularly interested in any modifications proposed during the forms' approval process that would substantially affect our use of these data.
