As an American who has worked and lived outside of the USA since 2000, and as an honest person who has always filed my taxes and submitted the FBAR forms as required, I think filing an FBAR every year is unnecessary. This information is nearly identical to what the US tax forms require now, so is obsolete. It takes me approximately 2 hours each year, not including the time it takes to gather the account information to do this form. I don't understand why the data could be collected once from US tax forms for Americans living Abroad and shared between different departments of the US government who need it. It is yet another inconvenience for citizens who live and work abroad. It must also be a cost burden for the government as well.
