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CDC guidelines allow a minimum of 22 sessions and a maximum of 26 sessions in a cohort but MDPP only reimburses for 22 sessions. This means that an organization who delivers the 26 sessions, would incur expenses for delivering 4 sessions but would not be eligible for reimbursement. Can the MDPP reimbursement align with CDC's 26 maximum sessions?

Page 5: Eligibility: States clinically diagnoses gestational diabetes mellitus during a previous pregnancy (... not allowed for MDPP participants). Page 5: D: Delivery Mode states that organizations "are required to submit a separate application for each delivery mode used". When an organization applies for CDC recognition, can the organization be provided with a Master Org Code and then modifiers be applied to that Master Org code for approval of any additional delivery codes. That way the organization has one Master org code and not an org code for each additional delivery modes. Also, if an organization has an existing org code and wants to add an additional delivery mode, would the organization be able to complete a shorter application or could the application form prepopulate with information from the initial application since the organization has already submitted an initial application?
