Thank you for contacting us about the RECS Federal Register Notice. The proposed survey form specifications are posted in the [EIA Survey Forms](#) page. Planning and testing is still on-going, so these are not considered final questionnaire content.

The ICR documents are still being drafted and are not currently available. A lot of the content that goes into those documents (e.g., sampling detail) are still being finalized, as well. Based on our timeline, we anticipate sending those to OMB for official review and approval in spring 2024.
